Funding Contributions

FedDev Ontario

- FedDev Ontario is the largest financial contributor to NSCFDC's operating funding, accounting for over 90% of the organization's general fund.
- Community-based projects are supported by our project partners and project specific funding agencies.

Results from fiscal operating year 2015 – 2016

Lending Activities

- > 20 loans were advanced in the amount of \$707,245
- Total Jobs impacted by loans 112
- Average loan size was approximately \$35,362
- Funds leveraged from 3rd parties \$117,000

Business Development Statistics from Lending Activities since inception (1986)

- Loan portfolio grants received from the Federal Government since inception = \$2,060,000
- ➤ Loan portfolio value as at March 31, 2016 = \$3.54 million (60 Loans)
- > Funds available for lending at March 31, 2018 = \$868,670
- > Since April 1986, \$14.5 million advanced to over 380 local businesses


Business Development Statistics from Lending Activities since inception (1986)
